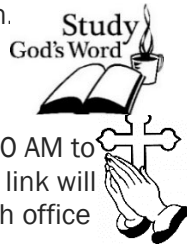

Bible Study—Thursday morning ZOOM:

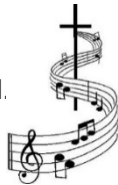
