There is a new creation happening (well, it's always happening, it's just sometimes hard to recognize) within our St. Paul, Penryn and St. Luke, Schaefferstown communities. Our music ministry is changing and growing with the addition of JP Welliver. John, our Administrative Assistant (and my right hand, sometimes left hand, at St. Luke) is entering into his final year of seminary and leaving St. Luke for his internship. With that, we are excited to welcome Andrea McCallister to the role of Administrative Assistant! The high school kids from St. Luke are working with me to be more engaged with youth in the Schaefferstown/Myerstown area and with our social media presence. The younger ones from Penryn are learning more ways to be worship assistants. Volunteers from BOTH congregations have been working beautifully together in the renewal of the food pantry at St. Paul, Penryn. Sunday worship has been so joyful and meaningful as we gather together to hear the word, are fed, are refilled and renewed by the Holy Spirit! Everywhere I look, I see and FEEL a new creation!

I continue to be blessed serving as your pastor. I am energized by the ministry, the faithfulness, the relationships between and among the two congregations. I have noticed the vocabulary switch in conversation: Many of you say "we" when talking about the other. It is no longer "they/us".

We are community. We are a new creation.

## St. Paul, Penryn Food Pantry Update

God's work continues to be evident and beautifully seen at the food pantry every week. We continue to welcome new families every Saturday, as well as grow and strengthen relationships between our volunteers and the folks in our community. The work continues, and I invite you to consider becoming a part of this amazing ministry!

Since the reopening of our pantry, the number of families that visit the pantry weekly continues to grow. In March, we served 49 families, which included 139 individuals. In April, we served 63 families, which included 208 individuals. In May, we served 106 families, which included 312 individuals. Folks are being fed every week, both physically and emotionally.

As the number of individuals utilizing the pantry grows, we continue to connect with more local partners for donations. In the past few months, in addition to the Kelloggs donation of cereal and Speedway donation of pizzas, we received donations from Wegmans and Giant. Both of those donations allowed us to provide meat for the folks who visit our pantry. We are currently in the process of connecting with the PA Central Food Bank to create a partnership with a local grocery store with the potential of providing weekly donations of meats, dairy products, and bakery items. We also continue to utilize the generous grant money awarded by our synod hunger committee to purchase food at very discounted rate (and sometimes free) through the PA Central Food Bank.

If you are interested in supporting the food pantry, there are several ways to become involved. Volunteers are needed every Saturday from 9 – 12. Consider coming in and helping to hand out food, carry food to the cars of our elderly visitors, or just get to know our neighbors. A behind the scenes volunteer opportunity is unloading and stocking shelves when the PA Food Bank food delivery arrives. This usually occurs on the second Wednesday of each month. Many hands make light work! Finally, if you are at the grocery store, consider adding a few items to your cart to support this ministry. Pastor Angie always includes pantry needs in her weekly email, if you are looking for specifics. If you forget, we can ALWAYS use paper products and personal hygiene items, such as paper towels, toilet paper, women's hygiene items, soap, detergent, shampoo, conditioner, etc.










## Konde Diocese Support



#### **Synod Assembly Update:**




